ADDITIONAL PERTINENT INFORMATION

- University seal permitted on products for resale (reviewed on a case-by-case basis)
- No alterations or overlaying graphics to seal permitted
- University licenses consumables (must have expiration date on packaging)
- University licenses health and beauty products
- University permits numbers on products for resale
- Cross licensing with other marks may be permitted with an additional agreement
- No use of current players' name, image, or likeness is permitted on commercial products in violation of NCAA rules and regulations
- No references to alcohol, drugs, or tobacco related products may be used in conjunction with University marks
- The use of the term "Cocks" on University of South Carolina product designs requires a special license type
- The use of the term "Cocks" requires the use of another University of South Carolina logo or word mark on the design
- The use of the term "Cocks" by itself is stictly prohibited
- "USC" must be accompanied by the full verbiage "University of South Carolina" where possible
- "SC" must be used in conjunction with another University mark.
